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## EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

**CYCLONE:** In the event of cyclone activity you will be advised by way of an early alert warning. Follow all instructions from radio, police, your accommodation managers or Disaster Management teams. In the midst of a cyclone remain indoors and monitor the radio.

**TSUNAMI:** If you feel an earthquake get off the reef and get to higher ground immediately, do not wait for a siren. If you hear on radio or TV that a tsunami may be coming stay off the reef, listen to the radio and follow all instructions. Follow evacuation signs and stay on high ground until police say it is safe to go back.

## TRAFFIC

- Speed limit is 40km within village areas and 60km open road - do not exceed speed limits
- Safety belts are strongly recommended at all times
- Remember to always drive on the left-hand side of the road
- Helmets on motorbikes are **COMPULSORY AT ALL TIMES**, for cyclists helmets are recommended. Ride single file and a light is compulsory at nights.
- Obtain a Niue Driver's License from the Niue Police Department NZD\$22.50
- Niue blood alcohol limits: .35mcg breath, 80mcg blood
- **NO PARKING** on the yellow lines in the main road of Alofi and the Government building car park
- No 'U' Turn at the Parliament Building or at any intersections
